Here are the directions for writing Aunt Polly Letters:

Materials:

40 envelopes 40 stamps
20 addresses 20 letters
20 sticky notes

1. Make a list of at least 20 addresses that you are going to send your letters to.
2. Type your Aunt Polly letter. It does not need to be exactly like the sample letter, make it your own. Just make sure that you include the tax information and the directions on how to send it back.
3. Print your Aunt Polly letter 20 times. Change the name and address each time so that each person feels as if they have received a personal letter, not a form letter.
4. Take 20 sticky notes and write your name once on each of these. Stick one note on each letter.
5. Take 20 envelopes and write YOUR Church's address on them. You can leave the return address portion blank.
6. Take 20 envelopes and write your 20 different addresses on them. Use either your church's address for the return.
7. Stamp all 40 envelopes.
8. Assemble your letters. Each envelope should include the following three items...
 - * letter
 - * church addressed stamped envelope
 - * sticky note with your name on it.
9. Turn these in on or before January 6th to your adult leader.
